Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. A completed entry consists of check and all required paperwork in the secretary's hands. Closing date - Postmarked by May 29, 2010.

Entries received after May 29 will be charged \$25.00 late fee/entry/division. Any entries after the closing date will be put on a space available list. Please include e-mail address on entry so we can notify you when your entry has been received.

******Earn points for the 2010 Heart of America Awards Presented in February 2011 at the Snowball Games Competition**** (☺)**

AWARDS: Team awards will be awarded on Sunday.

Division Entry: \$70.00 for the 2 day competition. \$90 for Non-MGAA members
Stabling: \$20.00 /stall/night. Tack Stalls: \$20.00/stall/night.

Field set up 8AM each day. All riders are expected to provide ring crew assistance during their session or assist during other sessions.*(☺)*

Divisions: Scores from Saturday and Sunday will be cumulative.

American Cup – Master Teams division. 4 or 5 riders This is an experienced rider division, fast galloping, experienced ponies, skills @ speed. Coaching permitted behind A-line.

Kangaroo Cup – Intermediate Teams division. 4 or 5 riders for those who are too fast for Novice, but doing skills at the canter. Not as fast paced as Masters. Coaching permitted behind A-line

Taylor Made Cup – Novice Teams division. 4 or 5 riders for riders who wish to ride slower, horses move slower to accommodate the need for skills at a slower speed. Coaching permitted behind A-line, no assistance allowed on the field, during the play of the games.

Koala Cup - Beginner Novice division. Teams of 4 or 5 riders. (may be adjusted to pairs if entries warrant). For riders new to mounted games. Coaching behind A-line & assistance on the field will be permitted.

Wallaby Cup - Family Pair & a Spare. 2 or 3 person Pairs competition. Fun division for the Parent/Child, Husband/Wife or Sister/Brother and a friend for a Spare!!! Games play may be fast, may be slow. Open Division all are welcome except Beginner novice level riders. Coaching permitted behind A-line.

*** 2 of the people must be related someway!!!!*

Margarita Cup - Adult Fossil Teams division. 4 or 5 riders playing at a moderate speed, usually Moms and Dads. Coaching allowed behind A-line.

General Information

Payment: Checks written to **HALF HALT PONY CLUB**

Weather Plans: The competition will be held regardless of weather. If for some reason the competition is cancelled, competitors will be notified.

Stabling: \$20.00 / Stall / night. Tack stalls or additional stalls are available at a **cost of \$20 per night** if available. Horses coming to the competition have priority over tack stalls. Shavings are available through **Hoosier Horse Park for \$7.00/bale.**

Food/Water: The concessions on grounds will be open for Breakfast, Lunch and supper. Water is available on the grounds. There are plenty of fast food restaurants, grocery stores and restaurants within 10 miles of Hoosier Horse Park.

Accommodations:

FORTY CAMPSITES and hookups are available at the Hoosier Horse Park @ \$20/night. Restrooms and showers are available for campers. Hookups include electricity. Some sites also have water hookups. Sites are first come first served.

The **Hoosier Horse Park** is located south of Indianapolis, IN, 4 miles west of I-65, 2 miles west of US-31. As you drive south on I-65, take exit #76B; follow the signs North to Edinburg. Turn west as the signs will indicate toward Camp Attabury. Across from Camp Attabury there will be a right turn on Schoolhouse Road, marked by a Hoosier Horse Park sign. The park is just a mile down this road, on the left.

In Consideration for the privilege of riding and working around horses at the **Indy games Cup competition** the undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify the **Mounted Games Across America** or it's officers, directors, **United States Pony Clubs, Inc, Heartland Region, Half Halt Pony Club, Competition Organizer, Hoosier Horse Park**, its officers, sponsors and members and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury or illness to Undersigned or any horse owned by me or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned on the premises of the **Hoosier Horse Park**.

I fully understand that riding and the playing of mounted games are very dangerous activities. I fully understand that riding is a very dangerous activity with many inherent risks including (i) The propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the rider, trainer, groom or handler, (ii) The inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons or animals. I wish to participate in these activities knowing they are dangerous. I accept and assume all the risks of injury (including death) to me or my property.

In exchange for being permitted to participate in these activities for myself, my heirs, guardian, and legal representatives, I release and agree not to make or bring any claim of any kind against the Mounted Games Across America or it's officers, directors , United States Pony Clubs, Inc., Heartland Region, Hoosier Horse Park, or its masters, officers, directors, members, employees, or guests or any landowners, landholders or the persons making property available for the Indy games Cup competition for injury (including death), to me or any damage to my property whether from anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising out of my participation in these dangerous horseback riding or related activities; and I also agree if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to me (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of those claims.
