# MGAA Open International Rider Application 2020

MGAA is proud to be accepting applications for the 2020 Open International Team. This year's team will be traveling to England to compete in the STRUK/XTREME "Rule the World" team competition June 20-21, 2020.

We are accepting applications from all MGAA riders including our Canadian members. Riders who have already taken part in previous trips are welcome to apply again, as each trip is different.

<u>Applications must be received by Friday January 31, 2020.</u> The MGAA Board of Governors will review each application and be selecting the team.

This team will be setting their own travel dates and arrangements and traveling as a five person team without a Manager/Trainer. Because of this, applicant maturity and independence is paramount. Although riders will be without a manager, the team will be inclusive for all riders and must work as a team in all aspects of the trip.

One rider will be listed as the organizer for the trip, and will coordinate with the rest of the team, and work with our international rep to plan the logistics and travel for the entire team. This team will also be responsible for their own transportation so a rider or two on the team will need to be capable and comfortable renting and driving a vehicle while on the trip for the team. This team may choose to rent an RV for transportation and accommodation or may choose to search for a bed and breakfast or Airbnb for the team and rent cars and or a van. While this team will be making their own arrangements, they will be traveling as a team, and adhering to the MGAA International Rep and Board of Governors requirements and standards.

Because this team will be determining the length of their trip, type of accommodation and transportation, and the plan for eating and any possibly touring, the expense to expect is variable. A suggested travel itinerary for a short trip with limited touring is June 17 - 23. Riders will be responsible for their own flight, a share of the rental vehicle and transportation,

accommodations, competition and pony expenses, as well as any food and spending money.

This is the first time we will be sending an Open team on their own and excellent representation of MGAA is most important.

# **Applicant requirements:**

- Be an MGAA member in good standing
- Be over 18 years of age or older as of January 1, 2020.
- Be confident and comfortable riding a variety of ponies.
- Be comfortable vaulting onto different size ponies.
- Be an experienced and skilled games player that has been actively participating in MGAA.
- Have strong horse management knowledge and experience. Taking exceptional care of all ponies is a primary necessity.
- Be mature and independent.
- Be financially responsible and prepared to fund their portion of the trip.
- Be an outstanding representative of MGAA.
- Be able to work as a team with different riders and accept coaching.

Have you been an MGAA member in good standing for two years or longer?

This is not a requirement to be a member of the team, and you should only say yes if this is something you are skilled at, capable of doing, as well as interested in doing.

Are you capable, and interested in being a driver while on this trip? This requires you to be able to rent (must be 25yo+ at the time of the trip) a vehicle, and also safety drive it. This is not a requirement to be a member of the team, and you should only say yes if this is something you are comfortable and confident at.

### **Team Member Code of Conduct**

- I understand that riding at any standard has inherent risk and that all horses may react unpredictably on occasions. I may fall off and could be injured. I accept that risk.
- I understand that instructions are given for my safety and agree to follow instructions given to me by the pony lender, and host. I understand that they may refuse to allow me to ride for safety, operational, or private reasons.
- I understand that the MGAA international rep, pony lender, and host make decisions based on the information I give them and agree to always be honest and volunteer information about:
- my abilities and riding experience, particularly my mounted games experience.
- any medical condition(s) which may affect my ability to ride.
- I understand that competing carries enhanced risk over and above general riding and agree that if I chose to participate in any competition or event, it is up to me to ensure that I have the experience and ability to compete on the pony I am given. If I am in any doubt, I will use my judgment and experience and withdraw myself.

Team members are always expected to:

- 1. Follow the directions of the pony lender and host.
- 2. Demonstrate a cooperative attitude.
- 3. Respect the privacy of others.
- 4. Be responsible for their own personal property.
- Be inclusive of all team members.
